Amazing Grace	Acappella solo, gradually add more voices	
Be Thou My Vision	Full choir, with Harp	Irish love song
Blessed Assurance	Full choir; organ and piano	
Eternal Father, Strong to Save	Male choir; with brass	
How Great Thou Art	v1 male solo; full choir; organ	Majestic
I Need Thee Every Hour	Women's trio to start; piano; simple	slow
In the Garden	v1 solo w/quartet on refrain; v2 women w/ full choir on refrain; v3 Tutti. Embellished old-time piano	
Jesus Calls Us O'er the Tumult	Full choir acappella	
Just a Closer Walk with Thee	start w/voices; add jazz ensemble	
Just as I Am	Full choir acappella	
Nearer My God to Thee	Choir w/strings; some unison, some 4 part on end	slow
Old Rugged Cross	M/F duet; piano	
Peace I Leave with You	Full choir, piano - to end the CD	
Shall We Gather at the River	Acappella quartet to start; add full choir	upbeat
Softly and Tenderly	Acappella quartet	
Standing on the Promises	Full choir, piano	upbeat
What a Friend We Have in Jesus	Male quartet, then choir ; brass	
When the Saints Go Marchin' In	Jazz ensemble to start; then add choir	upbeat
Whispering Hope	Full choir; strings, bells, flute, harp
